### KEY PROJECTS

#### Birtinya Retail Centre

\$45m Retail Development on a 9ha site, featuring Coles, Aldi, fresh food and over 40 new retailers.

#### Birtinya Town Centre

This proposed mixed-use development is comprised of commercial, retail and residential establishments including a new sewer pump, TMR intersection upgrades and Traffic Signals Design. Earthworks include surcharge preloading requirements, remediation works for acid sulphate soils and ACM.

#### Palm Lakes Resort

Stage 3, 4 and 5; 110 dwellings retirement resort and facilities with 120 bed aged care building, and other amenities such as Clubhouse and Bowling Green and TMR intersection upgrades.

#### Queensland Police Academy

This urbane renewal project is approximately 144ha comprising a new and renewed site infrastructure, new training facilities and academy, residential buildings and a central energy plant.

#### Bethlehem Retail Centre

20,000m<sup>2</sup> shopping center development situated in Bethlehem, Tauranga. The development comprises specialty stores, restaurants, cafes, service facilities and bulk retail.

#### Blackwater Mine Ramp 52 Water Storage Facility

New 400ML water storage facility, associated infrastructure (maintenance access roads and drainage, underground services, hardstand areas for power and mechanical infrastructure and truck fill points); and a sediment dam to be constructed upstream of the storage facility.
